

RIFLE MATCHES

BENCH-REST - 100 YARD

Competitors may shoot in either or both matches. Only one match score will be counted toward the Rifle and Club Championship.

Rim-fire Bench-rest 100 Yards

Held concurrently with the Center-fire Match on 100 yard range

- TARGETS: NRA A-25 (3 bulls-eye targets each). Will use two targets for score.
- GUNS: Any RIM-FIRE Rifle
- SIGHTS: Open sights and optics combined
- RESTS: Rests shall be comprised of a front rest to support the front part of the rifle, and a rear rest to support the rear part of the rifle; neither rest may be attached to the bench, the rifle or to the other rest, and each must be movable independently of the other. Bi-pods are acceptable.

COURSE OF FIRE:

UNLIMITED sight-in shots. Competitors may place additional targets on the frame for sight-in shots.

- Ten (10) shots at each of two (2) bulls-eyes. One designated target may be used only for sight-in shots.
- 20 minutes total, including sight-in shots.
- Ties will be broken by the number of X's and then by a shoot-off (5 shots).

Center-fire Bench-rest 100 Yards

Held concurrently with the Rim-fire Match on 100 yard range

- TARGETS: NRA A-23/5 (5 targets).
- GUNS: Any CENTER-FIRE Rifle
- SIGHTS: Open sights and optics combined.
- RESTS: Rest shall comprise a front rest to support the front part of the rifle, and a rear rest to support the rear part of the rifle; neither rest may be attached to the bench, the rifle or to the other rest, and each must be movable independently of the other.

COURSE OF FIRE:

UNLIMITED sight-in shots. Competitors may use other sight-in targets.

- Five (5) shots at each of four (4) targets.
- 20 minutes total, including sight-in shots.
- Ties broken by the number of X's and then by a shoot-off(5 shot
